- A. Indoor mask wearing- Reviewed latest CDPH statement. The SCVAL members will work collectively with, "All indoor athletes, with the exceptions of wrestling and competitive cheer, will hit the playing floor wearing masks. As exertion increases during play, athletes may remove their masks if the school is doing weekly testing. All individuals not involved in active play shall be masked throughout the game, including coaches, athletes on the bench, fans, scoring table staff, and officials".
- B. Discussion to whether the SCVAL BOMs wishes to pursue coming together with the PAL in football only so as to balance the levels of play within divisions and save programs with a focus to the safety of athletes. A sub-committee was formed to meet with members of the PAL BOMs to explore common needs and cooperation to the two football leagues coming together. Kami will contact the PAL Board President.
